# Make sure you have photo ID to vote at a polling station.

## Accepted forms of photo ID include:



Passports



Some travel passes



Driving licences



Proof of Age cards (PASS)



Blue Badges

## Check the full list of accepted ID at [camden.gov.uk/elections](https://camden.gov.uk/elections)

You must bring the original document – copies or electronic versions cannot be accepted. You can use expired ID as long as you still look like the photo.

If you don't have photo ID or you no longer look like your photo, you'll need to apply for a free Voter Authority Certificate by **5pm on 26 June**. You can do this at [gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate](https://gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate)



You can now apply for a postal vote online. You'll need to provide your National Insurance number – find out more and apply at [camden.gov.uk/postal-voting](https://camden.gov.uk/postal-voting) - you'll need to apply before **5pm on 19 June** for this general election



Register to vote quickly at [gov.uk/register-to-vote](https://gov.uk/register-to-vote) - you'll need to do this before **11.59pm on 18 June** to be able to vote in this general election
